INSTITUTION- PROFILE



r. Bhubaneswar Borooah Cancer Institute (BBCI) was set up by a voluntary organization called 'Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Society Trust'. Dr. Bhubaneswar Borooah (4th September 1893 - 25th September 1956) was a great physician, freedom fighter and philanthropist of Assam. The Institute was recognized as Regional Cancer Centre by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India in the year 1980. On 6th of August, 1986 the Institute was handed over to the Government of Assam by the B Borooah Cancer Society Trust retaining its autonomy. The First Tripartite Agreement for revitalization of the Institute involving the North Eastern Council, Government of Assam and the Department of Atomic Energy, Govt. of India became operational from November 1989. This tripartite arrangement for funding and management of the Institute continued till 2017. On a historical development, Dr. Bhubaneswar Borooah Cancer Institute (BBCI) on the 27th November 2017 has become a central institute under the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India and as a unit of Tata Memorial Center, Mumbai, following a decision of Cabinet Committee under the Chairmanship Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi. With his landmark decision, the hospital would be able to provide affordable cancer care across the entire North Eastern (NE) states with a holistic approach.

The Institute is a 230-bedded Hospital, land covering an area of 14.2 acres (43 bighas), located at Gopinath Nagar, Guwahati, Assam. About 12,000 new and 80,000 old cancer patients visit the Institute every year. The hospital provides Preventive, Diagnostic, Therapeutic, Rehabilitative and Palliative Support Services to all patients in addition to Teaching, Training and Research. Hence, the hospital is equipped with almost all necessary and latest technologically advanced machineries, developed in cancer fields required to treat patients in a holistic approach.

The Institute conducts various academic courses like MD in Radiotherapy, M.Ch in Surgical Oncology, DM in Medical Oncology, 2 Years Post Graduate Fellowship Programme in Head & Neck Oncology, Gynaecologic Oncology, Surgical Oncology, Medical Oncology and Onco-Pathology in collaboration with Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai, Ph.D, M.Sc in Radiological Physics and many other paramedical courses like Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT),, Diploma in X-Ray and Imaging Technology, Diploma in O.T. Technology, which are affiliated to Srimanta Sankardeva University of Health Sciences, Assam and Gauhati University.

Dr. Bhubaneswar Borooah Cancer Institute (BBCI), a premier cancer institute of North-East India was conceived way back in 1958. Set up by a voluntary organization

called 'Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Society

Trust' in the name of Dr. Bhubaneswar Borooah (4th September 1893 - 25th September 1956) who was a great physician, freedom fighter and philanthropist of Assam. The Institute was formally inaugurated on 18th November 1973 and became operational from 1974. The Institute was taken over by Department of Atomic Energy, Govt. of India on 27th November 2017 as a unit of Tata Memorial Centre, Mumbai. From a humble beginning to cater to the needs of the cancer patients of Northeast India, BBCI has come a long way and grown into an institute of national importance. The Institute located at Gopinath Nagar, Guwahati, Assam is a 260-bedded hospital at present and sees about 14,000 new and 1,00,000 old cancer patients every year.

Realizing the acute shortage of trained doctors, nurses and technical staff in the field of Oncology in the North-eastern states of India, Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute has always felt the need to generate manpower in this field in this region of the country.

The Institute at present conducts MD in Radiotherapy, M.Ch in Surgical Oncology, Head & Neck Surgery, Gynaecological Oncology and DM in Medical Oncology & Onco-Pathology. It is the first institute in the entire Eastern India to be granted permission to start courses in Radiation Oncology and 5 super specialty courses in Oncology by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India. Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute also conducts 2 Year Post Graduate Fellowship Programme in Head & Neck Oncology, Gynaecologic Oncology, Surgical Oncology, Medical Oncology, Onco-Pathology, Oral Oncology and Paediatric Oncology in collaboration with Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai.

MSc in Radiological Physics, recognized by the Atomic Energy Regulatory Board, Govt. of India was started in the year 2012 in collaboration with Gauhati University.

To understand the cause of cancer and its biology in depth, I am proud to inform you that Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute will be one of the few centres in the country to conduct a course in MSc Cancer Biology in collaboration with Department of Bioengineering and Technology, GUIST, GU from this year, i.e. 2018 onwards.

We understand that the paramedical staff is of equal importance in the smooth functioning of a medical institute. To improve the standard of care of patients attending a hospital,

we are also conducting courses in Radiotherapy Technology, Radiography, Medical Laboratory Technology, OT & CSSD Technician, Anaesthesia technician to name a few which are affiliated to either Gauhati University or Srimanta Sankaradeva University of Health Sciences, Assam.

Students undergoing nursing courses in various Nursing Colleges of N-E Region come regularly to BBCI to acquire knowledge in the field of Nursing Oncology as part of their training.

We have several short term Certificate courses for both doctors and paramedical staff. Summer training is imparted in Cancer Registry, Epidemiology & Biostatistics, Palliative Care, and Essentials of Molecular Biology Technique. Students from allied courses like MSW, Biotechnology from several institutes from all over India regularly visit BBCI for doing their internship projects. In collaboration with University of Science & Technology, Meghalaya, we have started MHA from 2020.

Researchers from within as well as outside the institute are pursuing various research works including PhD at BBCI. A DBT Centre for Molecular Biology and Cancer Research which was started in February 2010 and is involved in many research projects at present.

For clinical, academic and research collaboration, Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute has signed memorandum of understanding with the Dutch School of Gynaecologic Oncology and Pelvic Surgery, Netherlands, Manitoba University, Canada, Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kochi, Indo-American Cancer Institute, Hyderabad, Institute of Advance Study in Science & Technology, Assam down town University, University of Science and Technology, Meghalaya and National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Guwahati. The Institute has more than 300 research publications in national and international journals. BBCI provides residential accommodation for limited number of students. It also has a digital library.

Many of the students who have successfully completed various professional courses from BBCI have been absorbed in State and National Institutes of repute in the country. From this year, we have decided to start Post Basic Diploma in Oncology Nursing Speciality and M.Sc Medical Surgical Nursing in Oncology.

I assure you that this will be the right platform for gaining knowledge in various fields of oncology which will strengthen our mission to fight cancer.

I welcome you once again to Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute and be a part of the crusade against cancer.

Post Basic Diploma in Oncology Nursing

INC believes that registered nurses need to be trained in Oncology nursing care in clinical and community setting in order to provide competent care to cancer patients and enhance their quality of life. Expanding role of nurses and advances in technology necessitates additional training prepare them for effective participation in preventive, promotive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative nursing care. This course will help the registered nurses to be competent enough to give quality nursing care to the cancer patients.

Two Years M.Sc Medical Surgical Nursing (Oncology Specialty) agreement with Dr. B Borooah Cancer Institute, Guwahati

Pursuit to the interview we have had, we are glad to offer you as a student of	in

Oncology Nursing at Dr. B Borooah Cancer Institute, Guwahati on full time basis on the following terms and conditions:

- 2. The tenure of the Two Years M.Sc Medical Surgical Nursing (Oncology Specialty) is for a period of (2) two years at Dr. B Borooah Cancer Institute (BBCI), Guwahati.
- 3. Your anticipated course will be start from, 20......
- 4. Your will receive Rs. 10000/- (Rs. Ten Thousand Only) per month as stipend for the period of Two (2) years as non-sponsored students from the date of enrollment. Sponsored candidates (Government) won't be eligible for any stipend from Dr. B Borooah Cancer Institute.
- 5. You will not be entitled to any relocation expenses for purpose of joining Two Years M.Sc Medical Surgical Nursing (Oncology Specialty)
- 6. As per the BBCI policy it is necessary to document your presence while on duty. Therefore, "swiping in" and "swiping out" is mandatory.
- 7. You are required to be on duty round the clock as and when required, including emergency calls in rotation as per schedule. You will carry out the work assigned to you from time to time as per the instructions of your Superiors.
- 8. You will be required to perform the usual duty requirements of the department and will be responsible for issues pertaining to ward, OT, in-patient and out-patient care. Organizing and smooth functioning of multi-disciplinary meeting will also be a part of your duty schedule. You will also be an integral part of the team and will need to counsel, negotiate and manage work with personnel in allied specialties, so as to ensure comfortable patients navigation.
- 9. Your performance during the course is subject to periodical assessment every six months. BBCI reserves right to terminate from the course, if your clinical and academic performance at BBCI is found not satisfactory with a written notice of two months or two months' course stipend in lieu thereof. In case, you wish to leave the course midway, you are required to give penalty of a lump sum Rs. 25,000 (Rupees twenty five thousand) only+last month stipend and at least two months' written notice.
- 10. On the day of your joining, you are required to give an undertaking that you will not apply outside for any post or scholarship/fellowship or appear for any competitive examination without obtaining prior written approval from the Organization.
- 11. You are eligible to 12 (twelve) days all-purpose leave in a year as admissible without any form of accumulation. You are also eligible for special leave for presenting papers in conferences.
- 12. You will obey all the rules and regulations of the Organization in force from time to time for the said course.
- 13. Attendance at the Lectures and Meetings is compulsory failing it may not be possible to give you the certification for your tenure of Course, Seminars, meetings, faculty lectures, workshops will be a part of the curriculum. You will be expected to actively participate in such events. A point based CNE will also be devised for continued professional development. You will also be expected to perform regular audits on various issues related to patient care
- 14. Apart from Clinical and Professional responsibilities, you will also be expected to take active participation in Nursing Education, Clinical Research, Clinical Audit, Training, and Community Programmes and any other professional duties and needs of the Organization.
- 15. You will also be encouraged to present/publish Papers based on your work after due process of approval from the Principal, Oncology Nursing, BBCI and Director, BBCI.
- 16. You will administratively and functionally report to the Principal, Nursing as appropriate and as determined by the Organization from time to time for various activities and carry out the responsibilities assigned to you from time to time.

- 17. You shall devote your whole time and attention to your engagement with the Organization and shall discharge your duties such that you undertake not to engage yourself directly or indirectly with or without remuneration in any other employment or service.
- 18. This admission is subject to you being found medically fit by our Medical Consultant after a standard medical examination. In case there is any requirement for further investigations after the standard medical examination, the cost of such further investigation at BBCI will be borne by you. You are also subjected to the Organization's medical check-up by our Medical Consultant from time to time during the course of your engagement and the continuance of your engagement shall be subject to your being medically fit. In case you wish to resign from the course within a year of your admission, BBCI would reserve the right to recover the cost of the pre-employment health checkup from you.
- 19. Any misleading information furnished and/or suppression of facts or information by you explicitly or implicitly or discovered by us or having come to our knowledge, at any time, having a bearing on your selection directly or indirectly for the fellowship offered to you hereinabove, will automatically render this offer as cancelled without any notice to you, apart from your being liable for any such action as provided under the Law/ Rules and Regulations of the Government/BBCI
