Walk-in-interview will be held for selection of students for Post Basic Diploma in Oncology Nursing on 15th February 2021 (Monday) at 10:30 AM in the Conference Hall of BBCI. Out of total 20 seats, 15 seats will be under non-sponsored category and 5 seats will be reserved for sponsored category. Non-sponsored candidates will be offered a monthly stipend of Rs.6000/-per month. If suitable candidates are not found under sponsored category, the same number of seats will be considered for non-sponsored candidates. The non-sponsored candidates after successful completion of the one year course will have to mandatorily work for one year at a monthly stipend of Rs.17,790/- or as applicable stipend of Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai.

Walk-in-interview for M.Sc. in Oncology Nursing will be held on 16th February 2021 (Tuesday) at 10:30 AM. Out of total 10 seats, 5 seats will be under non-sponsored category and 5 seats will be reserved for sponsored category. Non-sponsored candidates will be offered a monthly stipend of Rs.10000/- per month. If suitable candidates are not found under sponsored category, the same number of seats will be considered for non-sponsored candidates.

Eligibility criteria for One year P.G. Diploma in Oncology Nursing: B.Sc. Nursing / GNM / PB B.Sc.N. Be a registered Nurse (N.N. &R.M.) or equivalent. Possess a Minimum of one year experience as a Staff Nurse. Be physically fit.

Eligibility criteria for Two years of M.Sc. Medical Surgical Nursing (Oncology Specialty): The candidate should be a registered Nurse and registered Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council. The minimum education requirement shall be B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks from an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council. Minimum of one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing. Minimum of one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc Nursing. Candidate should be medically fit. Five percent relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates will be considered.

For both the courses, the candidates with full bio-data along with original certificates and a set of photocopies should report before 9:30 AM on the respective dates.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of marks obtained in their degree / diploma examination (as applicable) and performance in the interview.
